Education Grant Criteria

Mangatu Blocks Incorporation offers Education Grants each year to support the educational journeys of our shareholders and their tamariki enrolled in secondary or tertiary education. This grant is available to help offset education-related costs and to encourage ongoing learning and development within Mangatu whānui.

The grant amount is subject to the number of applicants and shareholder approval at the Annual General Meeting (AGM).

You'll need your shareholder or whānau trust representative with you (if applicable) to complete part of this application. Please make sure they are present when you start the form, as they will need to provide their permission and contact details directly.

To be eligible, you must meet all criteria listed below and submit your completed application with the required documents by **15**th **of March**.
